Food concerns for yourself or someone else?

As the lockdown continues, it is possible that you or someone you know may need assistance sourcing food. Please email community@holytrinityoxford.org.uk for help from the One Canterbury community. For additional recommendations in Oxford more generally, read the Oxford Together food access information sheet here. To summarise:

- If someone is healthy and able and just needs information, there is guidance for Grocery and Supplies shopping in Oxford here. One thing to note is that if you can't get a delivery slot with a big supermarket, lots of local services are delivering.
- You can make a Practical Support request to Oxford Together using this form (https://forms.oxfordtogether.org/support-form), and the organisation will connect you with a Street Champion or Practical Support volunteer.
- If someone is in urgent food need, they can request a next-day Community
 Larder delivery using the same form. Someone will call them to make sure
 that all they need is a Community Larder box as it is only a top-up and
 if they need more assistance, will be able to provide that as a one-off (e.g.
 other foods, nappies, baby milk etc), as well as helping them access any
 additional food support they might require.
- If someone needs access to a Food Bank, <u>here</u> is a database of Oxford Food Banks.
