Liturgy sign-up is underway for <u>Sundays in March</u> and separately for the <u>Annunciation Liturgy & Doxology</u> which will be held on 25 March at 6pm.

Sunday 28 February marks Christ's Parable of the Prodigal Son. (The following week is meatfare in our preparations for Lent, with the customary fasting schedule.)

(As some will know he tested positive for Covid-19 this week and had a short, preventive stay in hospital where he could be better monitored.) Thankfully he had received the vaccine before falling ill, and is recovering well. Saturday of Souls ($\Psi v \chi o \sigma \dot{\alpha} \beta \beta \alpha \tau o$)

Next Saturday 6 March is set aside in the liturgical calendar as a Saturday of Souls. On this day we commemorate our brothers and sisters who have died, along with all those who have no one to request a Memorial Service for them. It is a customary day to visit and tidy family graves, and to give alms in the name of departed family members. We also contemplate our own deaths, with the comfort of remembering that on Saturday Christ lies in the tomb awaiting His Resurrection.

Kontakion: With the Saints give rest, O Christ, to the soul of Your servant, where there is no pain, no sorrow, no sighing, but life everlasting.

Apolytikion: O only Creator who out of love for man arrange all things with depth of wisdom, and impart to all what is beneficial, O Lord, grant repose to the souls of Your servants. For they have placed their hope in You our Creator and Fashioner and God.
