The schedule for Holy Week and Pascha will be reviewed by the Archbishop and shared with everyone shortly. The Church has to be well ventilated in the current health crisis, so please remember to **dress warmly!**

Sunday 4 April marks the third Sunday of Lent, dedicated to the <u>Holy Cross</u>. (The following week is a strict fast.) If you are at home this year, the text of the traditional <u>Veneration of the Cross</u> served after the Sunday Liturgy is available, and St Gregory Palamas' relevant homily can be read <u>here</u>, one possibility among many.

Sunday, 4 April there will be a two-year memorial service for Patricia Scott (1946–2019) after the Liturgy. The Auxiliary Association will be undertaking two memorial projects in her honour as well, details below.

Remembering Patricia Scott

Patricia Scott was an exemplary friend and parish volunteer who actively cared for an exceptionally wide network of people. She was Senior Nurse at Sobell House, served on the Holy Trinity and Joint Parish Councils, and was a trustee for the House of Ss Gregory & Macrina. Patricia also enthusiastically participated in and supported the hospitality and charitable work undertaken by the Auxiliary Association of St Andrew, which is now launching two projects in her memory — a newly commissioned icon from Crete, and a garden bench. We'll be launching a fundraising campaign next week, so please check back for information on donating.
