Dear Friends,

Christ is risen!

This week I want to draw your attention to two initiatives that our Archdiocese has begun. The first is a series of classes for young people, on the theme “Risen with Christ”, which started last week and will continue to the end of June. There are three sessions each Monday — the first at 5:00 p.m. for those aged 6-10; the second at 6:00 p.m. for those who are 11-15; and the last, for ages 16-25, at 7:00 p.m. All classes meet via Zoom. The second initiative is an evening event for those who feel that they may be called to serve our Orthodox Church as ordained clergy. On June 26th Archbishop Nikitas will host a Vespers service at Thyateira House, followed by a discussion on the opportunities for, and the challenges of ordained ministry in today’s Church. Those who want to explore a possible vocation at this event are asked to register via Privateoffice@thyateira.org.uk.

The last year has focussed our attention very much on our own life, our own home and our own community. 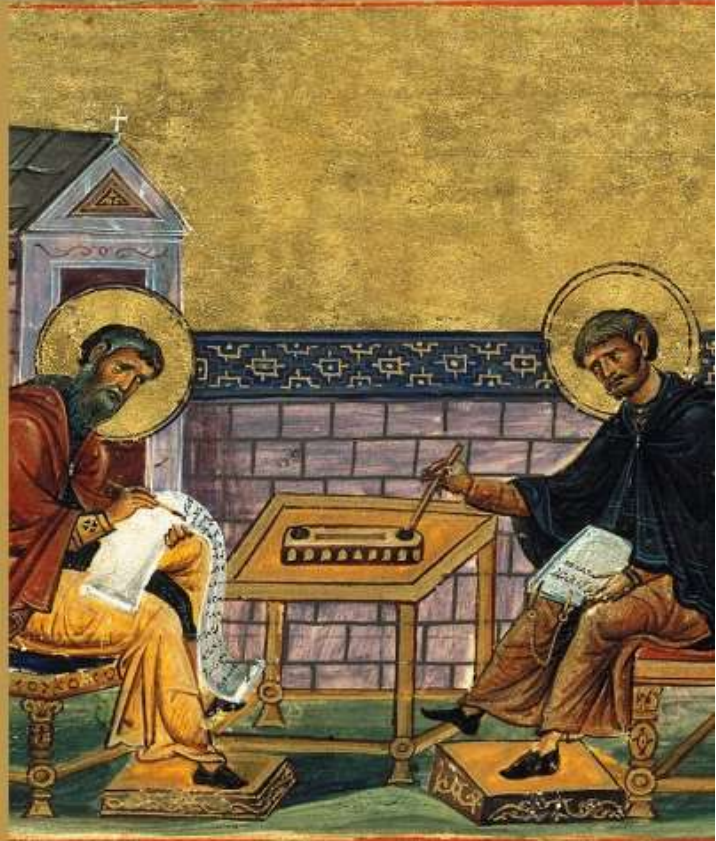
