On Saturday 3 June His Grace **Bishop Maximos of Melitene** ordained Deacon Anastasios-Brandon Gallaher to the Holy Priesthood in our church at Canterbury Road during the Liturgy for the Saturday of the Departed. His Grace was accompanied by Fr Theodoros Polyviou, priest of the Community of the Transfiguration in Coventry, and Fr Patrick Hodson (Dean of the Deanery of Parishes of Russian Tradition within our Archdiocese), Fr Ian and Fr Seraphim were concelebrants. Fr Anastasios-Brandon is of Canadian origin. He first came to Oxford 20 years ago, and he and his wife Michelle, and their children were regular members of our community for some years. He now works as Associate Professor of Orthodox Christian Studies at
