Celebrating Archbishop Nikitas' Name Day!

On Monday, 15th September 2025, more than 500 faithful from parishes and communities across the United Kingdom gathered at the Royal Lancaster Hotel in London for the annual Name Day Gala in honour of His Eminence Archbishop Nikitas of Thyateira and Great Britain, on the Feast of St Nikitas the Great Martyr. The evening — which supported the Archdiocesan Charitable and Educational Ministries — combined heartfelt tributes, fellowship, and celebration.

Archbishop Nikitas spoke briefly, focusing on the clergy's tireless service and dedication to the people of God. He invited all priests present to stand and be recognised, leading the faithful in a warm and sustained round of applause in gratitude for their ministry. The Gala was a resounding expression of the community's love for its Archbishop and its shared commitment to the mission of the Archdiocese.
